#### Sunday, October 4th is Life Chain Sunday.

Life Chain is a peaceful, prayerful witness of pro-life beliefs. Stand with us and thousands of pro-lifers throughout North America as we pray against the destruction of our pre-born brothers and sisters. We will gather in the St. Padre Pio parking lot at 1:55pm to collect our signs and then walk to the area of Islington and Major Mackenzie to pray from 2 to 3pm for an end to abortion. All social distancing rules will be strongly enforced and masks mut be worn.

Special Collection – This weekend, a special collection will be taken up for the needs of the Church in Canada. Each year the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops is asked to speak out, give leadership, or provide guidelines for the faithful on a wide variety of topics in our daily lives. In order for our bishops to be able to make proper judgments on modern topics, they must have the benefit of research and expert advice. Continuing research into the needs of our people needs to be carried on. Research and gathering information require staff, time and money. Finding ways to provide channels to

the Bishops from the people of God also requires resources. Through the yearly Bishop's collection for the needs of the Church in Canada, an appeal is made to all Catholics to be generous in supporting the work of their bishops. In addition to contributions, the members of the Church are also asked to pray for the work of the Bishops and to participate in and cooperate with the various projects of the CCCB. Envelopes are available at the back.

St. Michael - He is one of the seven Archangels. He is mentioned three times in the Book of Daniel. In the New Testaments, St. Michael leads God's armies against Satan's forces in the Book of Revelation, where during the war in heaven, he defeats Satan. In the Epistle of Jude, St. Michael is specifically referred to as the "archangel Michael." Catholic sanctuaries appeared in the 4<sup>th</sup> century, when he was first seen as a healing angel, and then over time, as a protector and the leader of the army of God against the forces of evil. He is the Patron of the Archdiocese of Toronto.

# Pope Francis' Prayer to Mother Mary during coronavirus pandemic

O Mary,

you always shine on our path as a sign of salvation and hope.

We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick, who at the cross took part in Jesus' pain, keeping your faith firm.

You, Salvation of the Roman People, know what we need, and we are sure you will provide so that, as in Cana of Galilee, we may return to joy and to feasting after this time of trial. Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform to the will of the Father and to do as we are told by Jesus, who has taken upon himself our sufferings and carried our sorrows to lead us, through the cross, To the joy of the resurrection. Amen Under your protection, we seek refuge, Holy Mother of God. Do not disdain the entreaties of we who are in trial, but deliver us from every danger, O glorious and blessed Virgin.

Amen.

Confirmation – The Archdiocese has now given us permission to celebrate Confirmation. These celebrations are only for those who missed the Confirmation in May and June because of the pandemic. Each school and class will be assigned specific dates from their perspective schools. Because of social distancing in the church, seating is limited – 10 people, including parents and sponsor, for each student. This is still a difficult time and we want to do all we can for our young people.

Sacraments for 2021 - The Archdiocese has not yet given us direction or permission to celebrate the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation for 2021. The only sacraments that may go ahead at this time are the First Communions and Confirmations that were missed in 2020. Those First Communions will be celebrated in October and November and the Confirmations will be celebrated in January and February of 2021. As soon as we hear anything from the Archdiocese, the schools will be informed and they, in turn, will contact the families involved.

**Sympathy** – We offer our deep sympathy to Livio Bastasin and his family on the death of his wife, Connie Bastasin, and to Gina Berardi and her family on the death of her husband, Silvestro Berardi. May God grant them His eternal peace and joy and send comfort to all who mourn their passing.
