A Guide to St. Padre Pio Church – This year we celebrate the 10th Anniversary of the Solemn dedication of our church. This is a good opportunity to learn about the church building itself. So, for the next while, we will have articles in the bulletin about various aspects of the church. We begin with 'The Vision' we had before the church was designed and constructed.

The Vision - In the Sacred Constitution on the Liturgy, the Second Vatican Council stated, "by way of foretaste, we share in that heavenly liturgy which is celebrated in the holy city of Jerusalem toward which we journey as pilgrims, and in which Christ is sitting at the right hand of God." The liturgy we celebrate here on earth is a sacramental participation in the liturgy of heaven. We share in the Wedding Feast of the Lamb. But it is not just the liturgy itself. The place in which the liturgy is celebrated also participates in the heavenly realities. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Our visible churches, holy places, are images of the holy city, the heavenly Jerusalem, toward which we are making our pilgrimage." (1198) So, just as the liturgy on earth is a mirror of the liturgy in heaven, so too is the church building on earth a mirror of the New Jerusalem, as found in the Book of Revelation.

Throughout the ages, architects and artists have transcribed the heavenly images of Revelation into built form and artistic form. The church building is a sacramental image of the New Jerusalem, the point where heaven and earth join together, the dwelling place of God among the people. This is the vision that we have tried to follow in the design of this church.
