**Rejoice Sunday** – Next Sunday is Gaudete Sunday or Rose Sunday. Gaudete is the Latin word for 'rejoice'. On that Sunday, the Church changes from its traditional Advent colour of purple to the colour rose. As a sign of joy, why not wear something rose-coloured to Mass next weekend.

Christmas Together: A Carol Concert – Normally, our annual Carol Concert is held on the First Sunday of Advent, but this year, because of the pandemic, it will be held virtually and livestreamed to your home on Sunday, December 13, which is Gaudete or Rose Sunday, at 6pm. Our talented musicians and singers look forward to sharing their special talents

and gifts with you, bringing the community together and relaying messages of hope, joy and inspiration through the power of music.

Christmas Angel Drive –This year has been especially challenging for those living in poverty. For this reason, St. Padre Pio Parish has decided to go forward with the annual Christmas Drive but in a modified, safe format. In partnership with Family Services of York Region (FSYR), we have launched a Christmas Angel Drive which will consist of monetary and gift card donations only. ## A Guide to St. Padre Pio Church THE AMBO

"Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of the prophecy and blessed are those who hear and who keep what is written in it."

The ambo is the place from which the scriptures are read, and the Gospel proclaimed. It is the table of God's Word from which the essence of the Christian proclamation is made, "Christ is Risen." Because readings from the ambo prepare us for the Eucharist, both the ambo and the altar are made of the same material, in this case, golden Jerusalem limestone.

#### THE BOOK OF GOSPELS

"Grouped around the throne were four living creatures...The first was like a lion...the second like a bull...the third had a human face...and the fourth was like an eagle."

These four living creatures from the Book of revelation have come to represent the four evangelists, and their symbols are found on the cover of the Book of Gospels, enthroned at the front of the ambo, from which the Word of God is proclaimed. For the Sunday liturgies, a special book of Gospels, with a gold and silver cover is used.

#### Christmas Joy! Christmas Mass Schedule

The following schedule is tentative as restrictions for the churches can change very quickly. All Masses will have musicians and a cantor only. There will be no choirs, brass or banner ministry. This year, because of the pandemic, and as per the Archdiocese, the congregation may not sing at these Masses, since droplets from singing can travel over 10 feet. Since we can only have 30% capacity, the Masses will be much smaller this year. For these reasons, there will not be a Midnight Mass this year. This will be a very difficult Christmas this year, but we want to keep everyone safe and healthy.
