

Covid Lockdown

The entire Region of York is now in lockdown because of the increase in infections. This also has an impact on our churches. By law, we must restrict attendance inside the church to 10 people. Sadly, due to these measures, by order of the Cardinal, Masses are temporarily cancelled until January 11th. This includes the whole of the Christmas season. Priests will continue to celebrate private Masses for the intentions of parishioners and for those suffering from the coronavirus. The church is open for private prayer during the normal times, but again, only 10 people are allowed in the church at any one time. The 10:30am Mass on Sunday mornings, Christmas morning and New Year's morning will be livestreamed on our parish website: www.stpp.church. We will continue to update vou as the situation evolves. You can check on our website or Instagram. This is a very difficult sacrifice we are making for the greater good. We pray that all of us will remain safe and healthy during this time.

The church is open for private prayer 8:00am to 7:30pm on weekdays **except for the following days**:

An Advent Service for the Home

A member of the family lights all four candles on the Advent wreath **Leader**: Rejoice the Lord is at hand.

All: Come, Lord Jesus

(A family member reads the suggested bible

passage for the day) Third Week of Advent:

Sunday Matthew 1:18-25
Monday John 1:1-5
Tuesday Luke 1-26-38
Wednesday Luke 1:39-45
Thursday Luke 1:46-56
Friday Luke 2:1-14
Saturday Malachi 3:1-2

Leader: The peace of the Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.

Leader: Let us pray. O God, who sent prophets to prepare the way for the coming of your Son, help us to hear their warning and their measure of joy which was given for all people; so that at the birthday of your Son, our redeemer, we may receive Him more joyfully into our hearts. This we ask through Christ our Lord. Amen

All: Our Father, who are in heaven...

Leader: May the Almighty and merciful God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, bless us and keep us.

All: Amen

Blessing of a Christmas Tree – Gather the family together to say a little Christmas prayer together.

"Dear Lord, the evergreen ranches of this tree are symbols of your everlasting light; the sparkling lights and decorations, reflections of your presence; the gifts beneath it, reminders of your many gifts to us. Help us to keep the peace and joy of Christmas in our hearts all through the year." Amen

Blessing of a Nativity scene – Make it a family project to put up your Christmas Nativity Scene. When the Manger is in place, plan to have a candlelight crib procession. Gather in the room farthest from the crib and turn out all the lights in the house. Mom or dad or an older child can carry a lighted candle and light the way as you process to the crib. You might like to sing 'Silent Night'. A younger child can carry the infant Jesus and place Him in the manger. Then kneel at the crib and read the Gospel account of the first Christmas:

(Luke 2:15-20) and say this prayer:

"Dear Jesus, bless this crib that we have set up in memory of your birth. Help us to remember each time we look at it that you came down to us at Bethlehem because you loved us. Remind us too that the presents we give and receive are given and received in the memory of your love. Bless our family and our world with peace and joy." Amen

Now process to the kitchen and have a birthday party for Jesus! Use the leader's candle to light the candles on a birthday cake (on which is written, 'Happy Birthday Jesus.' Sing the birthday song together, blow out the candles, turn on the lights and have a party. Talk about the first Christmas and what you think it might have been like, how Mary and Joseph looked or felt. Discuss what you could do as a family to give Jesus a birthday present.

Year of St. Joseph

With the Apostolic Letter 'Patrice Corde' (With a Father's Heart'), Pope Francis recalls the 150th Anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a 'Year of St. Joseph' from December 8th 2020 to December 8, 2021. He has also given this new prayer:

'Hail, Guardian of the redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you God entrusted His only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man. Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage, and defend us from every evil.' Amen.

The season celebrates the birth of the Lord Jesus and the ways he manifested the presence of God among us. But it is not just an historical celebration. Jesus continues to be born in our hearts today. He is forever, Emmanuel, God-With-Us. And with all the angels, we sing out our joyful proclamation, "Joy to the World", the Lord is Come!
