#### Return to the Red Zone

York Region is now back in the Red Zone during this pandemic. We still have to be careful – wearing masks, washing our hands and watching our distance. But at least now, we can return to having Masses again with 30% capacity. So, all weekday and weekend Masses will be celebrated again at the regular times

Confession Times – Now that we are in the Red Zone, confessions will go back to their normal hours – Saturdays from 4:00 to 4:30pm and Thursdays from 6:30 to 7:00pm

#### **First Communions**

The dates and times for First Communion Masses were given in December – by letter, in the bulletin and on the parish website. Now that we are in the Red Zone, the First Communion celebrations will proceed, starting this week. The times are as follows:

Tues. Mar. 2 – **Pope Francis School** at 6:30pm Fri. Mar. 5 – **St. Andrew School** at 6:30pm Sat. Mar. 6 – **Pope Francis School and the Public & Pivate Schools** at 12:00 noon

Tues. Mar. 9 – **St. Padre Pio School** at 6:30pm Fri. Mar. 12 – **St. Padre Pio School** at 6:30pm Sat. Mar. 13 – **Pope Francis School** at 12:00 noon Tues. Mar. 23 – **St. Padre Pio School & St. Stephen School** at 6:30pm

Fri. Mar. 26 - St. Stephen School at 6:30pm

Because of the limited capacity during the pandemic, only a small number of children at a time may take part in the Mass. This would also include 9 guests for each child, including parents. The Mass will be very simple – no singing (as per the Archdiocese), no lectors, no offertory procession and no group photos (as per the Archdiocese). Children may wear their First Communion dresses and suits but should not be wearing gloves or have anything else in their hands. Everyone, including the children should be wearing masks for the whole celebration.

This is a very difficult time and we are trying to do our best to serve the needs of our children and their families.

#### **First Reconciliation**

Because of the pandemic and the use of the church for regular parish Masses and First Communion celebrations, there will not be any First Reconciliation celebrations this year. The children's confessions will be heard at the school a week prior to their First Communion.

#### **Confirmations**

Now that we ae in the Red Zone, Confirmations will proceed according to the dates already given to the parents. The Confirmations that were missed in 2020 will be celebrated from April 6 to April 23. The Confirmations for 2021 will be celebrated from Apr. 27 to May 28.

#### **Stations of the Cross**

Because the First Communion Masses will be taking place on the Fridays of Lent, there will not be any Stations of the Cross this year. The pandemic has forced us to find times for over 40 Masses for First Communion and Confirmation. Next Year we should return to normal.

#### An Aid to Examining Your Conscience

The following based on the Ten Commandments is a list of questions to help you recognize what is sinful in your life. Remember also that some sins are more serious than others.

#### 7. You shall not steal.

Have I stolen or accepted stolen goods? Have I deliberately destroyed the property of others? Have I cheated anyone of what I owe? Do I gamble excessively? Do I share what I have with the poor and the Church according to my means? Have I pirated materials: videos, music, software?

## 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.

Have I lied? Have I sworn falsely? Have I plagiarized or been academically dishonest? Have I gossiped? Have I revealed secrets or confidential information without good reason? Have I ruined the good name of others by spreading lies or maliciously revealing their faults and sins?

#### 9. You shall not desire your neighbour's wife.

Have I deliberately and consciously permitted sexual thoughts about anyone besides my spouse? Do I guard my imagination and senses? Have I watched shows, plays, pictures or movies that contain impure scenes with the deliberate intention of being aroused by them? Am I responsible about what I read?

#### 10. You shall not desire your neighbour's goods.

Am I envious of the possessions, abilities, talents and beauty, or success of others?
