**COMMUNION FOR THE SICK:**

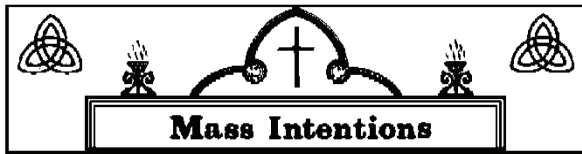
We are available to visit the sick in the home or hospital and to bring communion. Please contact the Parish Office.

**Trinity Sunday** – Today we celebrate the central mystery of our faith – The Blessed Trinity, three Persons, in one God. We believe that the one God is the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life. Each person of the Trinity is intimately involved in the world – the Father created the world, the Son redeemed the world, the Holy Spirit sanctifies the world. Yet they never act alone or separate from one another; they always act as the one triune God. From the creation of the world, the Trinity has been intimately involved in our lives. We should then, praise and adore the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, for in them is all life and love.

**Covid Retrictions** – have now been extended to at least July 4<sup>th</sup> for churches. Church attendance is restricted to 10 people. Masses will continue to be temporarily cancelled. The church is open for private prayer during the normal times. The 10:30am Mass on Sunday will continue to be livestreamed on the parish website: [www.stpp.church](http://www.stpp.church).

On Saturdays, there will be confessions from 4:30pm to 5:00pm followed by Communion Services from 5:00pm to 6:00pm. On Sunday, there will be Communion Srvices from 11:30 am to 1:00pm, with 10 people at a time. We will continue to update you as the situation evolves. You can check on our website or on Instagram.

**Confirmations** – The Confirmations that were scheduled from June 3 to June 25 will have to be rescheduled again. The four classes from 2020 (one class from St. Padre Pio school and three classes from St. Stephen School )will have their Confirmations the week of July 5<sup>th</sup>. The Confirmation classes for 2021, 10 in all, will have to wait until the Fall. Parents should have already received notices about the new dates. This is all beyond our control and we are trying to do our best for our young people.
