July 9 – St. Padre Pio School at 6:00pm As of June 30th, Churches are now allowed 25% capacity. So for the Confirmations each student may have 9 guests, including sponsor and parents.

Everyone should be wearing masks. Please arrive a half hour before the ceremony, as it takes time to seat the families safely. Please ensure that the Confirmation Card is brought to the ceremony. The Mass itself is very simple, no singing (as per the Archdiocese), no robes (as the company cannot distribute and take back the robes safely), and no group photos (as per the Archdiocese). The Mass will last about 40 minutes. At the end of the Mass, the pews need to be vacated immediately so the church can be cleaned. You may take pictures outside the church or come back during the week, when it is safe. Also, the Confirmations will be livestreamed on the church website at <u>www.stpp.church</u>. This is a very difficult time and we are trying to do our best to serve the needs of our students and their families.

Confirmations for 2021

All the Confirmations that were missed for the classes of 2021, will take place in the Fall. Parents should have already received notice of their particular date and time.

First Communions & Confirmations for 2022

Dates for the First Communions and Confirmations for 2022 will be given out in the Fall. We expect to be back to normal by 2022, so hopefully, the sacraments will be celebrated at the normal times – First Communions after Easter and Confirmations around the feast of Pentecost.

Baptisms

Upcoming Baptisms will be celebrated on July 11, July 18 and July 25

There will be a baptismal preparation class on Monday, July 26, 2021 at 7:30pm, at the church, for the parents and godparents of the children being baptized in August.

Weekday Masses – On Monday and Wednesday evening of the week there will be Confirmation Masses at 6pm. The 7pm Masses will continue as usual. However, because there will not be time to sanitize the pews after the Confirmations, parishioners are asked to use the side pews for the Parish Mass **A reminder** that the 10:30am Mass on Sunday is available to watch on our website: <u>www.stpp.church</u>. One half hour after Mass is over, it will be available for playback for one week.
