**Confirmations:** (for those who missed in May & June of 2021) Confirmation Masses will take place this week as follows; all beginning at 6:00pm Tues. Oct. 12 – St. Andrew School Wed. Oct. 3 – St. Andrew School Churches are now allowed 30% capacity. For the Confirmations, each student may have 9 guests, including sponsor and parents. Everyone should be wearing masks. Please arrive a half hour before the ceremony, as it takes time to seat the families safely. Please ensue that the Confirmation Card is brought to the ceremony. The Mass itself is very simple, no singing (as per the Archdiocese), no robes (as the company cannot distribute and take back the robes safely), and no group photos (as per the Archdiocese). The Mass will last about 40 minutes. At the end of the Mass, the pews need to be vacated immediately so the church can be cleaned. You may take pictures outside the church or come back during the week, when it is safe. Also, the Confirmations will be livestreamed on the church website at <u>www.stpp.church</u>. This is a very difficult time and we are trying to do our best to serve the needs of our students and their families.

**Weekday Mass** – Wednesday evening of this week there will be Confirmation Mass at 6pm. The 7pm Mass will continue as usual.
