Christmas Joy! Christmas Mass Schedule

Because of the growing number of people who are returning to church, we will have 8 Christmas Mases this year. Our capacity is still limited because of social distancing. This means that once all four sections in the church are full and with a limited number of people in the narthex, the church will have reached full capacity and the doors will be closed and no one else may enter. So please come early if you expect to get a seat. The Masses will be very simple, with musicians and soloists only, however, the brass will play at the midnight Mass. Another sign of good news, **we will be able to start singing again**. The Archdiocese has given us the goahead, a sign that the pandemic is slowly winding down, but we will still have to wear masks. It will be wonderful to hear everyone singing the Christmas Carols and all the parts of the Mass.
