New Pastor – The new pastor of St. Padre Pio Parish will be Father George Parayil. He is presently the pastor of Transfiguration of Our Lord Parish in Etobicoke. Born in India, he was originally ordained for the Syro-Malabar Rite of the Catholic Church. The Syro-Malabar Rite is one of the Eastern Rites of the Church. He was also a member of a religious order, the Sons of the Immaculate Conception. In 2017, he was incardinated into the Archdiocese of Toronto, leaving the religious order and the Syro-Malabar Rite, and becoming a Roman Catholic priest of the Archdiocese of Toronto. This year he is celebrating the 25th Anniversary of his Ordination to the priesthood. He will officially begin his ministry at St. Padre Pio Parish on Saturday, July 2, 2022. We welcome our new pastor!

Offertory Envelopes - PLEASE DO NOT USE ENVELOPES FROM PREVIOUS YEARS as we recently did a clean-up with unused Offertory Envelopes and have re-assigned numbers. Once you receive your new box, please make sure to write all your information (Name, Address, Phone Number as well as Email) for the first few weeks. We also ask that when writing a cheque please do not add multiple collections into one lump sum as we are not able to separate them when entering it into our data system. There is no need to leave multiple envelopes if a week(s) was missed, simply use the one envelope for the week you are attending and you may add the missed weekly donation(s) into the same envelope to avoid using multiple envelopes.
