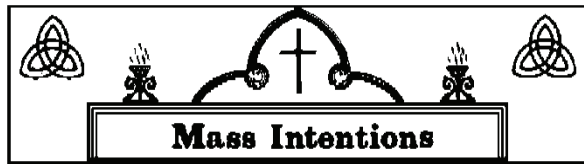
**COMMUNION FOR THE SICK:**

#### Canada Day – July 1

July 1<sup>st</sup> is celebrated as Canada’s birthday. A contemporary Christian should seek a responsible world view rather than a narrow nationalism, seeing our homeland as part of the family of nations. Canadians should seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and to continue working to influence those in government to act from Christian principals and attitudes. Christians, realizing they do not have a lasting home there, should pray and work for justice and peace in Canada and throughout the world, so that all God’s people may share in the goods of this earth. God’s Kingdom will come only when all people are ready to let Jesus’ teaching guide and rule their lives and actions.

*“Lord Jesus Christ, look on the people of our land and bless us all. Help us to be brothers and sisters to all the world, and to work for peace and love. Be with us Jesus, and bless Canada, for you are our Lord and Saviour for ever”. Amen*

**Your Personal Consecration** – Now that the family has consecrated itself to the Sacred Heart, each member should cultivate the habit of consecrating, daily all his activity to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This can be done by using any formula, but the formula proposed by the Apostolate of Prayer (The Morning Offering or the Daily Offering) offers these advantages: 1) It unites us with Jesus in all the Masses being offered throughout the world. 2) It is inspired by God’s love for people revealed in His pierced heart. 3) It invokes the intercession of Mary. 4) It shows loyal concern for the Church and her apostolic goals. 5) It puts into practice the spirit of prayer.

#### Our Family’s Prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for Other Families

Heart of Jesus, we pray

- For saddened hearts of families burdened by unemployment, poor housing, discouragement - Give them the courage of Your Heart
- For suffering hearts of families, weighted down by pain and despair – Join their sufferings to the wound in Your heart
- For the bitter hearts of families, shut off from you and from others – Let them feel the tenderness of Your heart
- For insensitive hearts unconcerned with the injustice and misery around them – Warm them with the compassion of Your heart
- For young hearts searching for a life worthy of total dedication – Give them the vision of Your loving heart
- For all hearts in need, that they may find the love of Your heart in the responsive, loving service of our family to them.

**My Daily Offering** – *O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer you my prayers, works, joys, sufferings of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sin, the reunion of all Christians. I offer them for the intentions of our Bishops, and of all Apostles of Prayer, and in particular for those recommended by our Holy Father this month.*

**Ordinary Time** – During ordinary time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God praise Him by celebrating the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord’s Day, God assembles His beloved people

to hear His word, to reflect upon it, to offer a living sacrifice of praise, to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from the apostles' time, for this was the day of the Lord's resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.

### **Welcoming Our New Pastor**

Next weekend, we welcome our new Pastor, Rev. Father George Parayil. A Pastor has a unique relationship to the parish community. He is their shepherd who is the co-worker with the Order of Bishops under the authority of the diocesan Bishop. A Pastor is obliged to see to it that the Word of God in its entirety is announced and that the faithful are nourished through a devout celebration of the sacraments so the Most Holy Eucharist is the centre of the parish assembly.
