All Saints Day commemorates all the saints of the Church, both known and unknown, who have attained heaven. The old term for this day is All Hallows' Day, 'hallow' being another word for 'saint.' The evening before All Hallows' Day was called All Hallows' Eve and then shortened to Halloween. Originally it was a day of preparation for All Hallows' Day or All Saints Day, but has since lost its religious connection. It is now celebrated as a secular day with costumes and decorations commonly associated with death.
