Corpus Christi Procession

There will be a procession on Sunday, June 2 following the 12:00noon mass celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The procession will take place in the streets of our parish community.

All are welcomed to join us in this celebration.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, observed this year on June 2, celebrates institution of the Eucharist.

The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Real Presence of Jesus — the Eucharist — in public. The feast of Corpus Christi was established in Liege, Belgium, in 1247. Pope Urban IV extended it to the universal Church almost two decades later, and the Corpus Christi procession followed soon after. Centuries later, the tradition continues at many parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto, including at the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Michael.

The North of 60 Food Drive.

The North of 60 Food Drive is a project organized by participating Saint Vincent de Paul groups in York Region to help our Canadian brothers and sisters in Taloyoak, Nunavut. Our St. Padre Pio Conference is seeking your assistance in collecting specific food items beginning the weekend of May 18/19 to support the Inuit in the Canadian Far North.

Taloyoak has no roads beyond the immediate community and it is impossible to grow crops there. This makes food prices very high. In fact, groceries cost 4-5 times higher than here in York Region.

If you can help, we are collecting the following items: Lipton Chicken Noodle or Onion Soup, Mr. Noodle Soups, Pasta, Pancake Mix, Cake Mix (Chocolate & vanilla), Banana Bread Mix, Minute Rice

***Please Note: Since food items will not arrive before the fall 2024, All Expiry Dates should be Dec 2024 or later

All food donations must be dropped off by the weekend of June 8/9, 2024.

The food will then be dropped off at a central location and loaded into a sea container. The container will be driven to Port of Montreal and then loaded onto the annual supply ship for Nunavut.
