God always gives you the means and the people and anything that you need to help out and help fulfill your Godgiven mission. Always keep your prayer life active and really understand: What are my gifts? What are my talents? What can I bring to the church? Ask God to help you to find the best way to do that.

## What are the benefits of volunteering?

It really gives you something back. I think everybody that's part of a parish should give in some way: time, talent, treasure, something. And you find it fulfilling as well. There are a lot of benefits that you don't necessarily realize at the moment: people that you'll get to know, friends you'll get to meet, and really that strong sense of community. That's what can get you through some very hard times.
