## First Communion and Confirmation 2024/2025

Information regarding dates and Catechism classes will become available at the beginning of the school year. Information will be shared with the school as well as on our parish website, weekly bulletin newsletter and pulpit announcement. Please be attentive to important dates and details that will be provided.

#### **Teacher Candidates**

The York Catholic District School Board, along with other boards, require that all applicants must submit a pastoral reference when applying for a position within the boards. It is the responsibility of the candidate to attend Sunday Liturgy, be involved in parish life and contact the parish priest well in advance. The pastor cannot complete the form if he does not know the applicant.

#### **EMAIL SCAM ALERT**

In recent weeks there has been a sharp increase in the amount of fake/scam emails being received by parishioners throughout the archdiocese. These emails – usually sent from Gmail accounts operated by scammers - appear to be from a priest and often request the purchase of gift cards or electronic payments. Please exercise caution should you receive an email like this and contact the parish via telephone to validate its authenticity.


