The St. Padre Pio Parking Lot Will Soon Be Paved

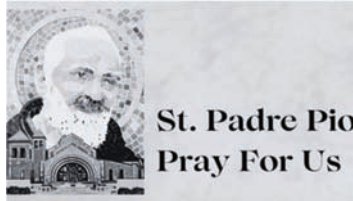
