### **First Friday**

Friday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, is the First Friday of the month. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00am, followed by the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Eucharistic Adoration will be available for personal prayer time until 6:30 pm with Benediction, during An Hour with Jesus, followed by the 7:00 pm Mass.

### **An Hour with Jesus**

Can you spend an hour with Jesus? What would you talk about? Come and find out every First Friday at 6PM, you can come and spend an hour with Jesus in praise and worship music, meditation, reflection and adoration – all in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. At the heart of Eucharistic Adoration is our Lord Jesus Christ – so come and spend some time with him. No formal prayer is needed. Just a willingness to meet with Jesus. People of all ages are welcome to attend, to sing, praise and have a dialogue with Jesus straight from their hearts.

### **Pour Out Adoration Night**

All of us are called to be saints. No matter your past or your present, God has a plan for you; one that calls you to greatness. All Saints Day having passed, this Pour Out night will reflect on the lives of the saints. We will ponder how God pours out His graces unto us and how we must respond!
