Eucharistic Adoration will be available for personal prayer time until 6:30 pm with Benediction, during An Hour with Jesus, followed by the 7:00 pm Mass.

An Hour with Jesus

Can you spend an hour with Jesus? What would you talk about? Come and find out every First Friday at 6PM, you can come and spend an hour with Jesus in praise and worship music, meditation, reflection and adoration – all in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.
