PROCEDURES FOR GETTING MARRIED Couples planning to be married must contact the Church at least one year in advance. At least one party must be a registered member of the parish. If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Archbishop's office has been consulted. Once a date has been set with the church, then the other arrangements, such as the rental of a hall etc., can be made. In preparation for the marriage, the Catholic party should be attending Sunday Mass each week. ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICES

Ash Wednesday is one of the most important holy days in the liturgical calendar. This day officially opens the Lenten Season - a season of fasting, penance, and prayer. The wearing of ashes on the head



symbolizes the dust from which God made us. As the priest applies the ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

FIRST FRIDAY DURING LENT Friday, March 7th, is the First Friday of the month. Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 am, followed by the Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Eucharistic Adoration will be available for personal prayer time until 6:00 pm with Benediction and the Stations of the Cross happening during An Hour with Jesus, followed by the 7:00 pm Mass.

AN HOUR WITH JESUS

Come and spend an hour with Jesus every First Friday at 6PM, with praise and worship music, meditation, reflection and adoration – all in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. At the heart of Eucharistic Adoration is our Lord Jesus Christ – so come and spend some time with him. No formal prayer is needed. Just a willingness to meet with Jesus. People of all ages are welcome to attend, to sing, praise and have a dialogue with Jesus straight from their hearts. March 7th & April 4th will include the Stations of the Cross.
