## **PROCEDURES FOR GETTING MARRIED**

Couples planning to be married must contact the Church at least one year in advance. This is an Archdiocesan rule across all parishes. At least one party must be a registered member of the parish or live within our church boundaries. Sacraments should always be celebrated at the church that you frequent or live within the boundaries of. Once a date has been set with the church, then the other arrangements, such as the rental of a hall, can be made. In preparation for your marriage, the Catholic party should be attending Sunday Mass each week. The couple should remember that they are preparing mainly for a marriage, not a wedding.
